



**Byco to resume sea fuelling operations: BEPA;**  
**Byco not responsible for oil spill near Mubarak village**

(Karachi, 1 November 2018) The Deputy Director Balochistan Environmental Protection Agency (BEPA) visited Byco's Single Point Mooring and Zero Point today, subsequent to its thorough investigation BEPA advised Byco to resume its sea fuelling operations with immediate effect today. This came in the aftermath of establishing absolutely no leakage or loss of containment from any of Byco's facilities, including the Single Point Mooring and associated pipeline. Byco has been fully cooperating with the authorities in their investigation and lending it's support to the cleanup operation of the beaches and coastline affected by the recent oil spill. Byco has continued its refining operations uninterruptedly.

"Byco is fully compliant with all relevant national and international safety standards and protocols and its facilities regularly undergo safety inspections by relevant authorities.
